**A HUNTER PACE** is a cross-country ride with a partner over a marked and timed course. It will include 2-3' jumps; riders may go over OR around all fences. The distance is between 8 and 9 miles. Awards will be presented in two divisions 1) Hunter (for those experienced in the hunt field and want to take the course at a faster pace, traditionally a fox hunt pace); and 2) Hilltopper (a more leisurely pace than Hunter, about 25% slower than Hunter pace). Everyone must complete and return the enclosed liability release form.

**TEAMS** of 2-3 will be limited to a time of go between 8 – 11 AM. Be on time; unfortunately, if you miss your time of go, due to large number of entries we cannot guarantee you another starting opportunity. Indicate on entry your preferred time of go and we will try to accommodate you.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$50 per rider includes lunch. Your entry will not be guaranteed unless accompanied by entry fee, which must be received by Sept. 10<sup>th</sup>. Early registration discount of \$5 for entries receive prior to 9/1/10. Negative Coggins and rabies within 12 months required with entry. Make checks payable to: *Lyme Equestrian Association, Inc.* and mail entry to: *Sarah Carlson, 3 Burr Road, Old Lyme, CT 06371.* Entry fees will be refunded in full up to Sept. 10<sup>th</sup>. After Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> no entry fee will be refunded without a note from a doctor or veterinarian.

**CHECKPOINT:** Riders must check in for a mandatory 3 minute hold at the half-way mark.

**Please Note: There will be a used Tack Sale held in conjunction with the Hunter Pace!! Don't miss this opportunity to purchase gently used items for your horse!**

**DIRECTIONS:** *From I-95 South – Exit 70, at the end of ramp, go straight ¼ mile to Tee; turn right on Rte. 156 North; go 2.6 miles; Lord Creek Farm on left.*

*From I-95 North - Exit 70; at end of ramp go left onto Rte. 156N; go 2.6 miles; farm on left.*

*From Rte. 11 South to Rte. 82 West - go south on Rte. 156 for 6 miles, farm on right.*

## SAFETY RULES

1. Horses must be sound: all equipment must be in good repair.
2. Safety helmet and shoes with heel required; chin strap required for those under 18 years old.
3. A safety check will be made prior to the ride. If tack and mount are considered unsafe, entry fee will be refunded.
4. No minor child may be left on the grounds unattended.
5. A warm up area will be provided.
6. Red arrows on yellow or white background will mark the direction of the ride.  
***FOR SAFETY REASONS, DO NOT RIDE OFF MARKED TRAILS.***
7. Please do not bring pets.
8. Please rebuild any jump you might knock down because a fallen down jump can be very dangerous for those who are still to come.
